Fiscal management memo from the Colonel

Most of you are aware of the recent issues with the County Finance Div. and the situation the County is now in financially. With this in mind the entire County will be in difficult times financially at least this year and next year, and, perhaps beyond.

The Sheriff is looking at ways to cut our budget and to that end has had the first two brain storming meetings with his staff

to identify ways to cut the budget. Many more such meetings will follow. In those meetings, we are looking at many areas where difficult decisions will have to be made now and in the future. Many of the changes and cuts in spending will be implemented as soon as they are identified as so you will begin seeing some of this immediately. Our meetings are documented and you will find the meeting minutes in public folders, and on our intranet site at www.mcso.net.

Sheriff's office Gym Card and Identification check in process

Just a note about who is allowed to use the Sheriff's Office gym:

The only people allowed to use the gym are actual cardholders. Cards are not to be used by anyone other than the person who applied for the card. Remember: when you go to the gym, you must have a picture ID with you for identification verification. The Sheriff's Office will be performing random checks of cards and ID's. Offending individuals will be asked to leave and the card they are using will be confiscated. Sheriff's Office employees are allowed to bring a guest with them to the gym, but other card holders are NOT allowed to bring guests.
