Now Hiring Detention Deputy Trainees For Upcoming Corrections Academy

Date: August 20 to December 7, 2007

Location: Florida Keys Community College (FKCC), 5901 College Road, Key West

Hours: 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday (unless otherwise scheduled)

- **Description:** The first week is 40 hours of Orientation taught by the MCSO training staff. The Academy is 532 hours of Florida Corrections Basic Recruit Training. Successful completion of this course is required to take the State Corrections Officer Certification examination.
- **Qualifications:** Applicants must be at least 19 years of age, a United States Citizen, a High School Graduate or equivalent, have a Florida Driver's License and a responsible driving record, must not have been convicted of a misdemeanor involving perjury, false statement or any felony, have not received a dishonorable discharge from any of the Armed Forces of the United States, be able to pass a Florida Department of Law Enforcement record check and medical examination, be able to pass a background investigation, pass the Criminal Justice Basic Abilities Test (CJBAT), and pass the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) test (if applicable).
- **Tuition and Salary:** MCSO pays the tuition which includes registration costs, books, supplies and some uniform items. In addition, you are paid salary of \$31,865 per year while attending the Academy. Candidates must sign a two year Officer Training Agreement.

Artists Invited to Submit Designs Easter Seals 2007 Ornament Will Feature The Bridges of Monroe County Deadline for submission is June 30, 2007

Local artists are invited to submit designs for the annual Easter Seals Holiday Ornament, which will be produced late summer for holiday sales. A Keys tradition since 1989, the collectible gold-over-brass ornaments are produced in a limited edition by the Charleston Mint and sold throughout the Keys to raise funds for Easter Seals. First State Bank partners with Easter Seals, ensuring that the ornaments are available county-wide.

Past artists have included Joshua Peters, Rebecca Burg, Ann Irvine, Dick Moody, Eric Grahl, Tina West and others.

This year's theme is "**The Bridges of Monroe County**"

"We pass over them every day and every day we see something different" said Easter Seals Operations Manager Barbara Divoll. "Pick your favorite bridge and your favorite view and create a piece of art."

The best designs feature an image or shape that is recognizable from a distance and include many spaces to be die-cut, which give the ornament a rich filigreed look upon closer inspection.

Amateur, student, and professional artists may submit designs, which must be original art work and done as a pen and ink with accommodation for an arc on the topside. Photographs are also acceptable. Submission dimensions must be square and able to be reduced to 3x3 square inches. The deadline for submission is June 30, 2007.

The designs must be accompanied by a brief title (no more than five words,) the artist's signature, name, address, phone number and e-mail address. Also include a paragraph about the subject and how it has affected the artist.
