Low Cost Housing Program

At Andrew Jackson University we are always looking for information valuable to law enforcement officers and our criminal justice students. This information on a unique and little-known low-cost housing program may be of interest to your officers. Please circulate this email through your communication channels.

Low Cost Housing for Law Enforcement Officers

HUD offers a substantial incentive in the form of a discount of 50% from the list price of a home to full-time sworn law enforcement officers, firefighters and EMTs who participate in HUD's Good Neighbor Next Door Program. The discount applies to homes located in designated community revitalization areas. In return for the discount you must commit to live in the property for 36 months as your sole residence.

Go to your home page <http://www.aju.edu/monroe> and click on the Good Neighbor Next Door link to see what this HUD program is all about. You can select properties by city and state. Home prices are list price. You must use a HUD-approved realtor to bid on a property. You bid the list price, but only have to finance half the amount. HUD holds a second mortgage on the other half, which is cancelled after you live in the house for three years. If you don't find something that interest you, check back soon, listings change frequently.

Andrew Jackson University has no interest in the HUD program and receives no benefit if you choose to participate; it is simply our way of alerting you to an issue that may interest or benefit you and your coworkers.

Don't forget, all employees of your department, sworn and unsworn, are automatically qualified to receive the Rubenstein Scholarship, equal to 25% of your tuition at Andrew Jackson University.
