Workforce Commute Shuttle

The City of Key West Department of Transportation is pleased to announce that a new route will be added to the public transit system next month.

The new route will be called the "Workforce Commute Shuttle" and as its name suggests, the route will concentrate on getting commuters to and from work at peak travel hours. It will provide dedicated service at limited pick up and drop off points between Big Pine Key and Old Town Key West during the morning and afternoon rush hours.

This additional shuttle provides an economical and environmentally friendly alternative to driving personal vehicles to work. It will also take more cars off the road which will decrease traffic congestion along US 1 and within the city.

Service will begin on May 1, 2008. A list of stops and schedule will be available in the near future on the Department of Transportation's website at www.keywestcity.com and posted in the buses.

Police Unity Tour

Every year hundreds of law enforcement officers are killed in the line of duty. Nothing can ever replace them to their family and friends. The National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C., allows for their memories to live on and honors the men and women of law enforcement.

This year, Key West Police Officers Kelly Thomas, Nicholas Revoredo, Christine Coker and Janeth Del Cid are joining the Police Unity Tour to raise money for the National Law Enforcement Memorial. The Unity Tour consists of a 250-mile bicycle ride from Chesapeake, Virginia, to Washington, D.C.

The memorial has the names of all law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty engraved on it. This year, the officers will ride for the officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty from the Key West Police Department and other police departments in South Florida.

The Key West team's goal is to raise \$6,000 in pledges by May 1, 2008. All pledges are fully tax-deductible.
