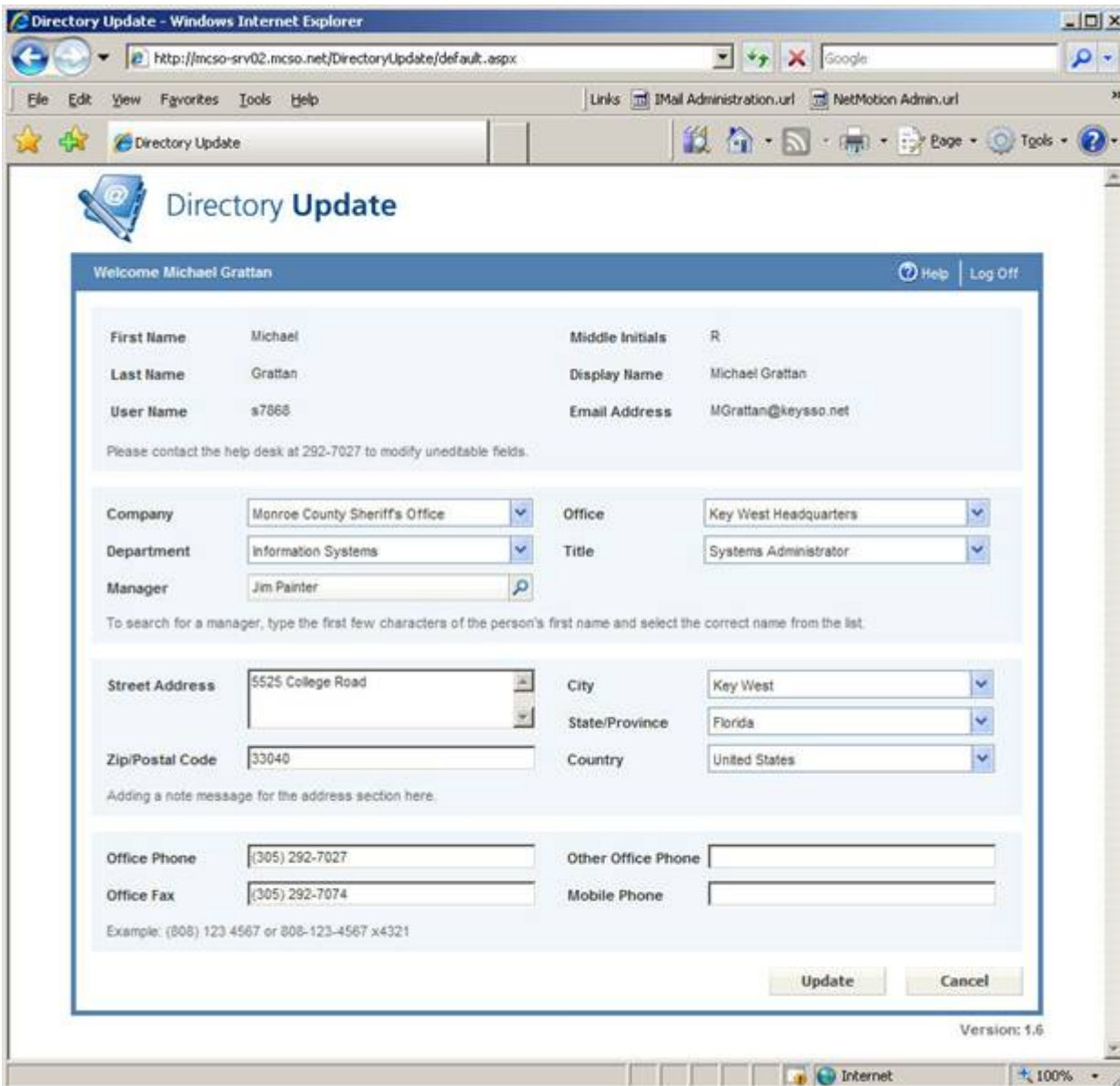

Update your Outlook Address Book listing

The Information Systems team has created a link on the black MCSO intranet homepage (mcso.net) allowing MCSO members to update their own information in the Global Address List in Outlook. The link is in the left-hand column at the bottom and is labeled "Directory Update". When people click on it, they will be taken to a sign on screen where they can enter their usual Windows username and password.

Then they will see a screen like this:



Here, people can enter their own information or chose from one of the choices in the drop down boxes. When they're happy with the information, they can click on the "Update" button and the information will be stored in the online address book that is used by all. Please take the time to update it....some people's information is WAYYYYYYYYYY out of date.

Family member or legal guardian must have Justice FCU membership for minor to be eligible for this account. This account must be opened in the name of the minor under their own Social Security number. This offer is available on a minimum and maximum deposit of \$1,000. There is a penalty if funds are withdrawn prior to maturity date. Account maturity is the 18th birthday of the minor. At maturity funds are transferred to a Student Checking Account with VISA debit card. A penalty will be imposed for early withdrawal from the Grow With Me account. Fees or other conditions may reduce earnings.
