

PROPER IDENTIFICATION FOR FINGERPRINT REQUEST

1. Reasonable reliance on the presentation to the fingerprint technician of one of the following forms of ID.
 - A. A Florida ID card or driver's license issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles.
 - B. U.S. passport issued by the Department of State
2. Reasonable reliance on the presentation of any one of the following forms of ID, if the document is current or has been issued within the past 5 years and bears a serial or other identifying number, and, if the document is a passport, the document is stamped by the U.S. INS
 - A. A passport issued by a foreign government
 - B. A driver's license issued by a territory of the U.S. or a state other than Florida or by a Canadian or Mexican public agency authorized to issue drivers licenses
 - C. An ID card issued by a territory of the U.S. or a state other than Florida
 - D. An ID card issued by any branch of the armed forces of the U.S.
 - E. An ID card issued by the U.S. Department of Justice, INS
